Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are happy to inform you that cookery in Home Economics classes will resume this week. In accordance with the guidelines published from the DES please see some of the guidelines for these classes below:

- Students will now cook independently in class – this increases students responsibility to ensure that they have their ingredients in class and also have looked at the recipe before class so they are confident in the steps involved.
- Due to students cooking independently, your child will be cooking on alternating weeks. The other students will be accommodated for in another classroom with a teacher and supplied with revision work to complete.
- Due to COVID 19 students will no longer be able to weigh ingredients at school – this must be done at home.
- Students are asked to use a clean, sterile lunchbox to bring their ingredients to school – please ensure that this is clearly labelled with the students name. This lunchbox must also be used to bring food cooked in class home.
- Masks must be securely worn at all times during a cookery class and extra sanitation will be required at the beginning and end of class.
- Students may bring in their own aprons, cloths, oven gloves etc if they would like to but alternatively can use the school supply which will be washed at 60c at the end of each class.

We would appreciate it if you could take the time to talk to your child about these guidelines and how important their implementation is in keeping our school community as safe as possible.
